**SUBJECT: REOPENING OF THE UNIVERSITY FOR
CONTINUING AND NEW STUDENTS**

Pursuant to the directive from the Ministry of Education on reopening of universities, and in particular, resumption of learning in phases, we wish to inform the following continuing students –

- a. Diploma in Procurement & Logistics Management Module 6 and Module 2,
- b. Diploma in Hospitality and Tourism Management Module 2,
- c. Diploma in Business Administration Module 2,
- d. Diploma in Journalism, Year One – Semester Two (1.2),
- e. Diploma in Film Production and Animation, Year One – Semester Two (1.2),
- f. Diploma in Strategic Public Relations, Year One – Semester Two (1.2),
- g. Diploma in Electrical & Telecommunication Engineering, Year Three – Semester Two (3.2)
- h. Year One – Semester Two (1.2) September 2019 Cohort in all Faculties and
- i. Year Two – Semester Two (2.2) B.Sc. in Electrical & Telecommunication Engineering as follows; that they are required to report at main Campus on Monday 4th January, 2021 for face to face learning and examinations. Learning will start strictly from Tuesday 5th January 2021 for Three (3) weeks to Friday, 22nd January 2021, and Examinations will start from Monday 25th January, 2021 to Friday 5th February, 2021.

All new Students (2020 1st year Cohort) who are currently undertaking learning on Virtual/Online mode are required to report at the main Campus on **Monday 8th February, 2021** for face to face learning and examinations. Learning will start strictly on Tuesday 9th

February 2021 for six (6) weeks up to Friday 19th March, 2021 and Examinations will begin from Monday 22nd March, 2021 to Friday 2nd April, 2021.

Further, all reporting students at level 1.2 are required to:

- a. **Clear any pending fee balance before reporting to the University.** Each student can confirm fees status in respective (student's) portal or if need be, consult the Finance Department through Lennox Kaudo, email: lkaudo@mmu.ac.ke or Patrick Njiru, email: pnjiru@mmu.ac.ke
- b. Students who were accommodated in the University Halls of Residence (those at 1.2) before closure of the University in March 2020 due to COVID 19 Pandemic will be accommodated upon reporting on 4th January, 2021 on first come first served basis, and in line with Ministry of Health COVID-19 social distancing requirement. Accommodation is therefore not guaranteed. Some students shall be required to seek for accommodation outside the University.

Students at level 1.1 (2020 1st year Cohort)

The Government of Kenya (GoK) Sponsored students shall be charged K.shs 2110/= (Kenya shillings two thousand one hundred and ten only) for accommodation and Self sponsored (SSP) shall be charged K.shs 4220/= (Kenya shillings four thousand two hundred and twenty only) for accommodation for the period Monday 8th February 2021 to Friday 2nd April, 2021.

The University will release a detailed Academic Calendar for 2020/2021 academic year for all cohorts of students in January 2021.

Please take responsibility and share this communication with your parents/guardians/ sponsors, colleagues and peers, and make adequate arrangements to report to the university for learning and examinations as required.
