
On reporting, the new students will be expected to:

1. **Bring the following documents for verification.**
 - i. Original and copies of letter of offer
 - ii. Original and copies of National ID Card or Birth Certificate for those under 18 years of age **OR** any other document(s) that can be used for identification
 - iii. Original and copies of KCSE result slips/KCSE Certificate, Leaving Certificate and any other Academic transcripts (where applicable)
 - iv. Dully filled students detail forms (MMU/F/AD/001-012)
 - v. Four (4) Colored Passport Photos
 - vi. Parents' copy of NHIF card, Identity card or any other Medical Insurance policy number for medical cover among other documents specified in the letter of offer.
 - vii. Medical Report. **Note a Chest X-tray is mandatory**
2. **Clear any pending fee** balance before reporting to the University. All students are required to confirm fees status in their respective student portals.
3. **Pay accommodation fee** as follows for the period Monday 8th February 2021 to Friday 2nd April, 2021
 - i. All Government of Kenya (GoK) Sponsored students - **Kshs.2110.00**
 - ii. All Self Sponsored Students - **Kshs.4220.00** for accommodation



Note: Accommodation space is limited and will be allocated on first come first served basis.

4. Commencement of Teaching and Learning and other scheduled academic activities will start on **Tuesday 9th February 2021 from 8.00 a.m.** It is the students' responsibility to register for units.
